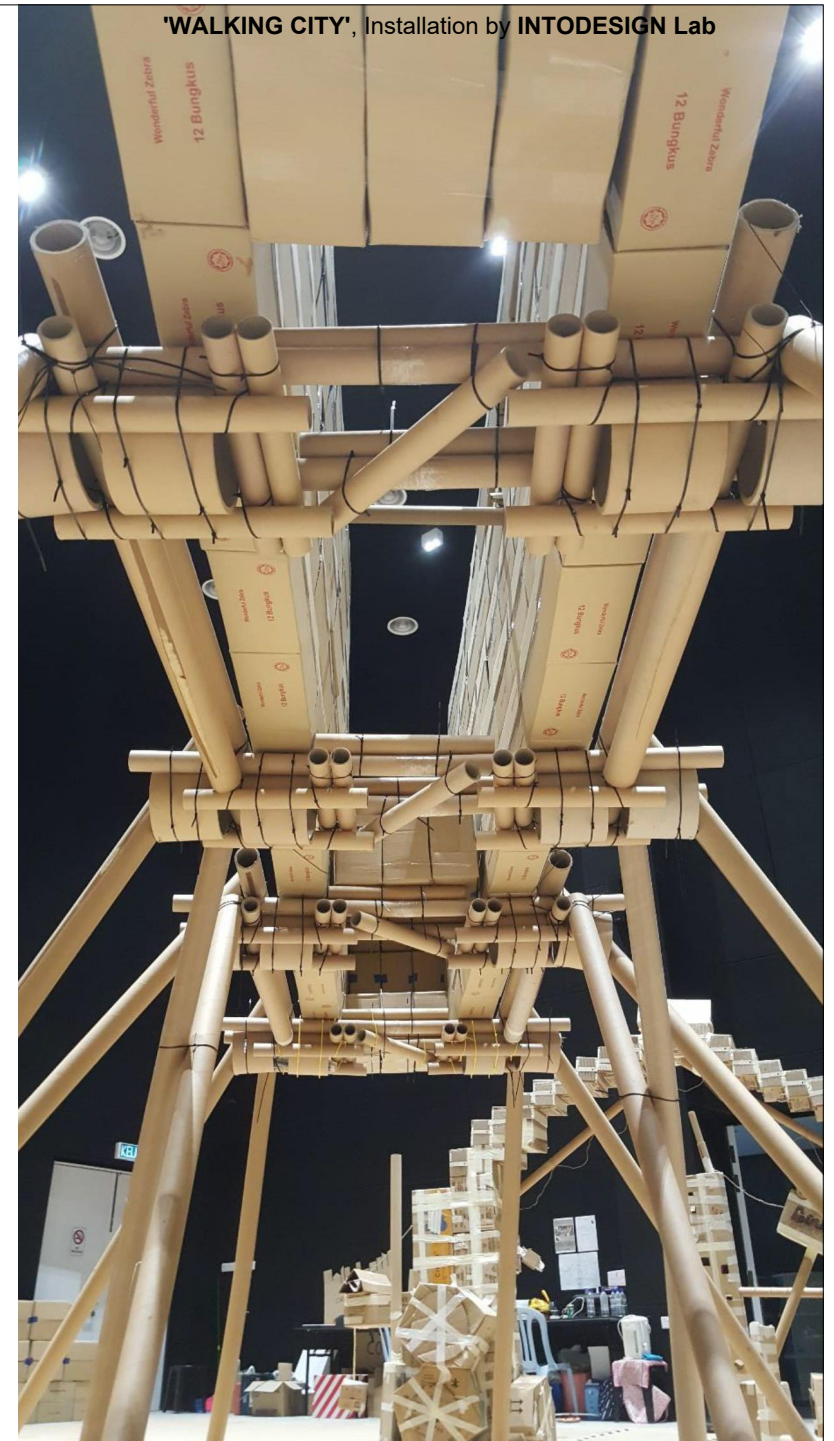

THE BACKGROUND OF THE EVENT

The **Cardboard City** is open to primary school children, with assistance from architecture college and university students, graduate students and architects. The challenge is to create a **'large scale toy event'** to inspire young minds through architectural spatial experience. The aim is to encourage learning through creative play. As **21st Century Learning**, children open up their minds to what is possible, take chances, solve problems, collaborate and become better creative thinkers and makers.

In 2017, 12 primary schools with a total of 240 children participated in the **'Cardboard City Challenge'** installation. A further 120 students from local colleges and universities volunteered for the event. It was a collective effort of 360 students working together to design an 'Imaginary Future City' from cardboard and tapes with an approximate 400 m² footprint. The event was a success with 1800 people from the public turning up during the last two days of **'Cardboard City Play Day'**.

INTRODUCTION

For the **World Architecture Day 2018** celebration, **Pertubuhan Akitek Malaysia Sarawak Chapter (PAMSC)** and co-organiser, **INTODESIGN Lab** are organising the **Cardboard City Challenge** for the second time with more participants and exciting programmes, which includes the launching of this **Cardboard Pavilion Competition**. All members of PAMSC and students are invited to participate in this pavilion installation with the theme - **Re-imagining the Future**. The shortlisted finalists' entries will be constructed and installed during the Cardboard City event.

What is more exciting than exploring architectural ideas, geometries, forms, systems and experience constructability with cardboard? Submit your entries now!

Architecture plays an important role in inspiring everybody, especially the younger generation. Thus, we aim to reach out for creative designs from the public through this interactive family event. The competition is to design a **Cardboard Pavilion** to house creative learning activities for children and inspire them through architectural spatial experience.

ELIGIBILITY

The competition is opened to all Malaysian architects, graduates, university and college students. All participants must complete the registration form and submit by **20th June 2018**.

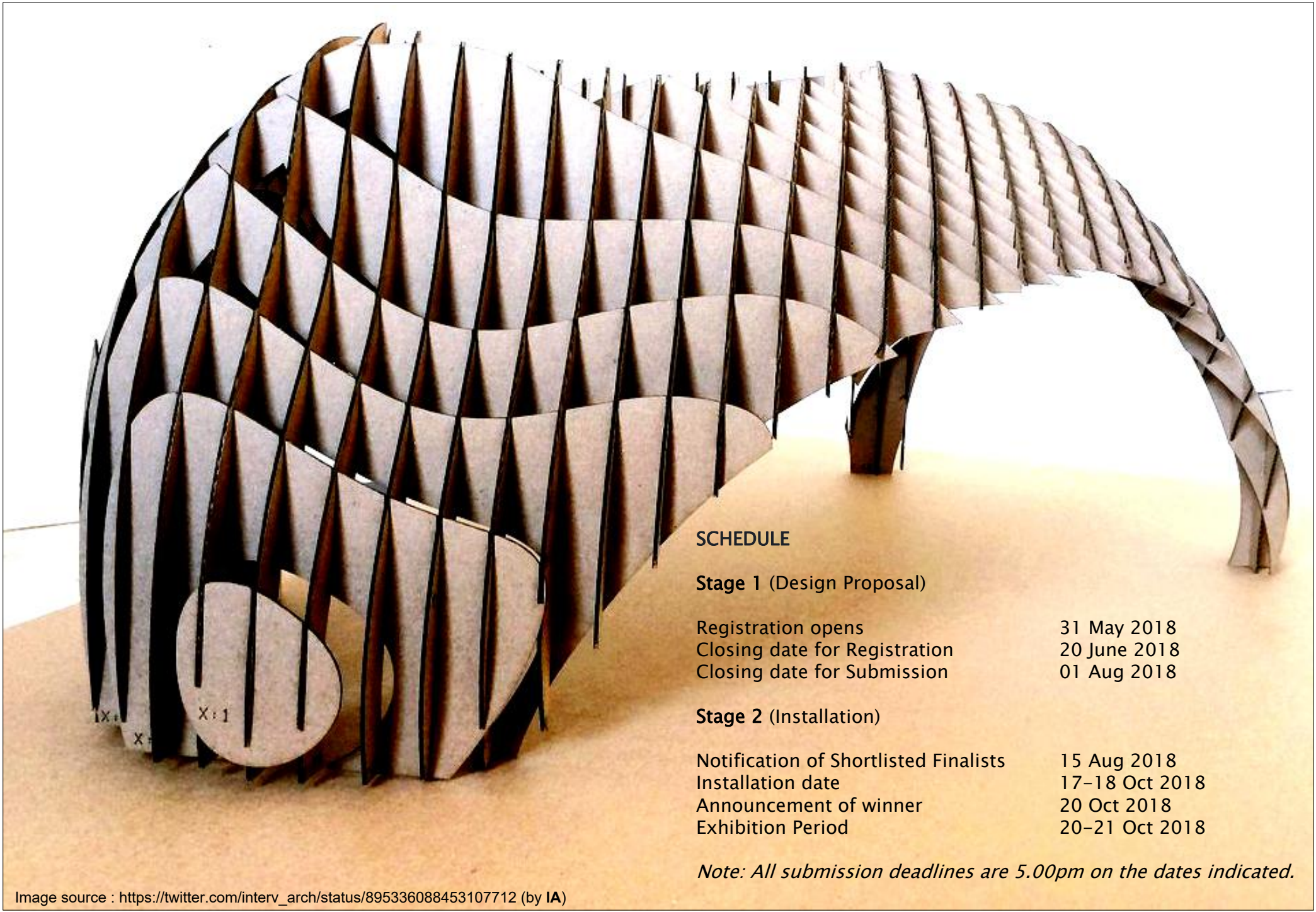

THE TASK

The challenge is to design **Cardboard Pavilion** with a **minimum of 2.4m (width/length) x 2.1m (height), not exceeding 9.3m²** within a team. Each team should consist of four to six people. Please consider the function of design as a space to host children activities during the exhibition.

You have the freedom to design either a single shelter or structure that fits the programme decided by your team. The five Shortlisted Finalists will be required to construct one to one scaled pavilions.

Participants only have a duration of one day for the installations. However you have the following flexibilities:

- Pre-construct and deliver the pavilion to the event venue
- Pre-construct the parts beforehand, deliver and install at the event venue
- Construct and install at the event venue

The organisers will not provide material and tools at the event. Participants who fail to complete the installation by 18 Oct 2018 will be disqualified.

VENUE

Dewan Serbaguna at Kompleks Belia dan Sukan Negeri Sarawak. The Cardboard Pavilions will be installed as part of the 'Cardboard City' built by the primary school children on approximately 300m² footprint.

SUBMISSION REQUIREMENTS

Participants are required to submit via email to info@pamsc.org.my **four (4) A3 landscape-orientated** presentation boards, in JPEG format (must not exceed 15mb per jpeg) with the following:

- Plans, elevations, sections
- Sectional Details
- Sketches or rendering of perspectives
- Diagrams to explain your proposal
- Design statement to be included on the boards

The presentation boards must not indicate any information related to individual or team's identity. Participants who do not comply with the requirements will be disqualified.

INSTALLATION

- Installation Date: 17 & 18 October 2018
- Venue: Dewan Serbaguna, Kompleks Belia dan Sukan Negeri Sarawak
- Duration: Four (4) hours per day for two (2) days
- Time: 1pm – 5pm
- Exhibition Date: 20 & 21 October 2018

JUDGING CRITERIA

- Stage 1 design proposal will be evaluated based on creativity, design concept and approach.
- Stage 2 installation will be judged on quality of workmanship, innovation, technical solution, spatial qualities and overall aesthetic.
