Draft for New Housing Policy in Sarawak

Ministry of Urban Development & Natural Resources Sarawak (MUDeNR) was instructed by Sarawak Planning Authority (SPA) to look into a current housing policy in Sarawak. The current policy in Sarawak covers private and public housing development including normal housing, SPEKTRA housing, PUTERA housing, SRI PERTIWI housing and PRIMA housing, etc.

The main concern raised up by SPA was the review of housing design in consideration of the COVID 19 pandemic situation, especially on affordable/low cost terraced housing developments.

A one-day lab session was conducted by MUDeNR on $2^{\rm nd}$ July 2020 to deliberate among relevant agencies with the aim of preparing a draft policy. PAMSC was represented in both working groups (low rise & high rise) by Ar. Stephen Liew & Ar. Chai Si Yong. The other participants were representatives from SPA, MLGH, HDC, L&D, BDA, MBKS, DBKU, Bomba & MIP.

A draft proposal was agreed and finalized for further presentation by ${\tt MUDeNR}\,.$

On $7^{\rm th}$ July, PAMSC was invited to the presentation by MUDeNR to YB Datu Haji Len Talif at Wisam Sumber Alam. The presentation was led by Head of Planning, Encik Wan Sufian Wan Mustapha. The draft was accepted and will be presented in an engagement session with stakeholders.



A fruitful stakeholder's engagement session took place on $9^{\rm th}$ July, in Auditorium PUSAKA, Wisma Sumber Alam. The draft proposal was further deliberated by members from SHEDA, IEM, DID & etc.

The draft proposal for New Housing Policy in Sarawak were presented by MUDeNR in SPA Meeting on $14^{\rm th}$ July 2020 for decision.

- C. Transport
- D. Utilities
- E. Basic Infrastructure
- F. Digital Transformation

Under Basic Infrastructure - Building Catalytic Initiatives headed by JKR Sarawak, on the 7th July 2020 PAMSC was invited as part of JKR Sarawak private sector engagement to come up with catalytic/game changer initiatives to move forward the 3 initiatives for this category. These are:

- 1. IBS (INDUSTRY BUILDING SYSTEM)
- 2. GBI (GREEN BUILDING INDEX)
- 3. BIM (BUILDING INFORMATION MODELLING)

This will be a working group to enable the formulation of strategies and policies which aligns with Sarawak's Aspiration 2030.
