



#### **Lands and Surveys Building Plan Submission Form** - Amendment


- With immediate effect all the consultant architects are responsible to provide/ supply all vital information required for the submission of building plan.
- A Building Plan Submission Form is to be filled by the consultant architects, a copy of which is attached and the list of documents to be submitted are as follows:-
  - (a) Building Plans
  - (b) Copy of Approved Subdivision Plan
  - (c) Survey Plan to be certified as true copy by licensed surveyor
  - (d) Plotted Plan (the survey plan must be used as the base for the plotted plan to indicate building setbacks, permitted out buildings, extensions, patios and balconies, etc.)
  - (e) Extract of Title
  - Copy of approved building plan (if relevant)
  - (g) Completed Part I & Part II of the Building Plan Submission Form.



#### **EULOGY** of the late Ar. Wan Ismail bin Dato' Haji Wan Othman (1966-2006)

Born in March 1966, Wan Ismail bin Dato' Haji Wan Othman obtained his Masters Degree in Architecture (May 1990) from Washington University in St. Louis, United States of America. In 1990, he joined Konsortium Malaysia as an Architect and later, he formed Arkitek KM Sdn Bhd in 1998 to practice as Principal Architect when the Architectural Section was segregated. He obtained his Professional Architect licence from the Lembaga Arkitek Malaysia in 1997.

Among the many projects that he steered were Markas Briged Pasukan Gerakan Am (PGA) at Batu Kawa, Kuching, Mukah Coal-Fired Power Station, Pusat Latihan LHDN in Kuching, Markas Briged Pasukan Gerakan Am (PGA) at Sri Aman, Pejabat LHDN Cawangan Kata Kinabalu in Sabah and Pejabat Jabatan Penerangan Sarawak in Kuching (Proposed TUDM Hangar, Kuching).

Wan Ismail left behind his wife, Noor Aishah binti Salleh and four sons, aged 13, 10, 9 and 7. He is always known as a loving, caring and understanding father by his his family. Among his friends, he is known as friendly and kind-hearled person. In the office, he was always looked up by his staff as a Mentor as well as a generous man.

# FRUITFUL DISCUSSION AT WORKSHOP ON REGULATORY ISSUES

KUCHING – About forty members of Pertubuhan Akitek Malaysia Sarawak Chapter (PAMSC) attended the half-day Workshop on Regulatory Issues Relating to the Architectural Practice held on March 4 (Saturday) at the PAMSC Secretariat, Queen's Court beginning at 9am.

Ar. Ng Chee Wee chaired the workshop and several issues were brought up for discussion. Participants also discussed and exchanged ideas on issues and challenges facing the practising architect today especially in areas involving regulatory framework and issues such as delays in approval applications, non-uniform interpretation of Bye-Laws, new guidelines and conditions being imposed without prior consultation or notice were also discussed.

The workshop was struc-



tured around three key stages – 1. Identifying common problems and issues faced by practising architects; 2. Formulate suggestions and solutions to the problems and issues; and 3. Formulate a strategy and Plan of Action.

"We had a good and suc-

cessful workshop today as we got good turn out from architects and graduate architects who discussed regulatory and other related issues. Among the participants were our past chairman Philip Chang and the Mayor of Miri Citly Dato' Wee Han Wen. We are planning to



set up a sub committee to look into the various issues brought up during the workshop and to recommend solutions to improve the situation," Ng said after the workshop.

### Exclusive interview with Ar. Dr. Ting Ing Chiew

## HIS FATHER'S ABILITY INSPIRED HIS CHOICE TO BE AN ARCHITECT

AR. DR. TING ING CHIEW of Ting & Rakan was inspired to take up architecture because of his father's ability to design their own family home at Sungei Sadit in Sibu as well as other timber managers' residences and labour lines at the Lee Hua Sawnmill before the Second World War.

He decided to pursue it as a career and graduated with a Bachelor of Architecture from the University of Melbourne, Australia in 1964. He set up his own firm Ting & Associates in Sibu two years later.

"I am not the earliest as by then, there were other architects Ar John Lo and Ar. Andrew Tan," Dr. Ting said.

"When I first started up, the general public does not know how to differentiate the professional services offered by an architect and an engineer. To them, both disciplines are the same. On top of that, we have to 'compete' for professional fees with building draughtsman and engineers. Architects then may be offered only RM250.00 per unit of terraced house," Ting recalled.

Architecture has come a long way since then as the standard of architectural de-



sign has improved tremendously. The public are also beginning to appreciate the value of a good design by current practising architects involving housing and industrial projects, he added.

For the future, Dr. Ting said that in order to gain further public confidence and strengthen the position of the architectural profession in building and construction industries, practising architects must be creative in design, to fuse function with form, resulting in the creation of building forms and structures as work of arts.

He further observed that to be a successful architect or architectural firm, several elements are essential, such


