Ar. Alan Lau, a native of Kuching, Malaysia, obtained his Bachelor Degree in Architecture with honours from the University of Western Australia, Perth. He went on to work with SAA Architects in Singapore, and eventually with renowned firm WOHA in 2004. While working with WOHA, he worked on numerous architectural and interior design projects, including NOMU apartments, The Met apartments in Bangkok, Alila Villas Resort Uluwatu in Bali, the Hyde apartments in Sydney, and the Park Royal Hotel on Pickering Street, Singapore.

Since 2011, he has been a Director with award-winning Kuching-based architecture firm IDC Architects, where he has helmed a diverse portfolio of projects ranging from architecture and interior design, to art installations and urban-planning. He worked on the pioneering Eden-on-the-Park active retirement resort in Kuching, a residential and care facility aimed at creating a new model of senior-friendly living for Malaysia. He also worked on the interior design for the new headquarters of the Sarawak Tourism Board, Kuching, which won a Malaysian Institute of Interior Designers award for design excellence at the 2019 MIID REKA Awards.
