BIOGRAPHY:

Andra Matin - both the man and the firm, andramatin, are known for their clean and modern approach to architecture. Aside from his architectural projects, Andra Matin is also one of the founders of Arsitek Muda Indonesia (AMI - eng: Young Architects of Indonesia), and has been a part of the progress in Indonesian architecture, and cofounder of Bintaro Design District, an annual design festival that connects Indonesia's creative community with the public.

His installation titled Elevation has been granted a Special Mention Award at the 2018th Venice Biennale and Banyuwangi Airport won the Aga Khan Awards in 2022. His projects have been featured in various architectural publications, including his monograph by Thames & Hudson, Tropicality: Houses by Andra Matin in 2024. Inspired by his great love of travel, Andra Matin continues to search out more knowledge and experiences, in order to further celebrate the architecture of Indonesia.








































BIOGRAPHY:

He has received multiple accolades, including ARCASIA Gold Medals and ASA Awards, and his work has been showcased globally.

Beyond architecture, he transformed Bangkok's Khlong San area into The Jam Factory in 2014 and now chairs the Creative District Foundation. From 2023, he serves on Thailand's National Board of Soft Power Strategy, promoting cultural industries. Duangrit's career blends design excellence, urban regeneration, and advocacy for Thailand's creative and architectural innovation.



Adj. Prof. Ar. Dr. Tan Loke Mun, a pioneering Malaysian architect and sustainability advocate, is the founder of ArchiCentre, DTLM Design Group, and DrTanLM Architect. A graduate of Deakin University and the University of Melbourne, he co-founded the Green Building Index Malaysia, advancing national environmental standards.

His S11 House became Malaysia's first GBI Platinum-rated residence, setting a benchmark for ecological living. Recipient of the PAM Gold Medal and numerous regional awards, Dr. Tan continues to shape future generations through his commitment to green innovation, community engagement, and architectural education toward a sustainable built environment.
